- -When it cancelled our AGM in Hawaii, we adapted...and held the first ever virtual AGM on Zoom---which everyone agreed was better.
- -Because of that, we held the first-ever Special General Meeting (SGM) in December with more members registered than for any prior IFFR event.
 - -All three Regional VPs are now regularly holding Zoom meetings with their section chairs.
 - -Various sections are now regularly holding Zoom meetings with their section members.

We are all adapting to the pandemic... to make things better.

<u>Fellowship logos.</u> All Rotary Fellowships, including IFFR, are having to rethink their logos to conform to RI's new branding rules. IFFR leadership will carefully review our options, adapt for the best interests of IFFR, and report back...to make things better.

<u>Membership</u>. A year ago, RI adopted new rules expanding membership eligibility in all Fellowships to any interested individual. IFFR leadership will carefully review this new rule, adapt for the best interests of IFFR, and report back.... to make things better.

CONCLUSION: It's been a challenging year, but we'll continue working to make things better. During 2021, I will strive to join you at IFFR events around the world. Count on it.
